

Division Descriptions

Lead Line- Open to riders 7 years of age and under. Judged 50% on child's hand and seat and 50% on the mounts suitability. Maybe asked to drop and pick up stirrups and reins. **May cross enter in to Mini Short Stirrup only.**

Mini Short Stirrup- Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Judged on hand, seat, legs. General position & control of mount. **May cross enter in to Lead Line only.**

Beginner Equitation- Open to riders 11 years of age and over. Judged on hand, seat, legs. General position & control of mount.

Short Stirrup Equitation- Open to riders 10 years of age and under. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. May cross enter into Cross Rail Hunter.

Long Stirrup Equitation- Open to riders 11 years and over. Judged on hands, seat, legs, general position and control of mount. May in cross enter into Cross Rail Hunter & Hopeful Hunter.

Cross Rail Hunter- Open to horses & ponies. Judged on the manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 18", Trot or Canter fences and simple changes will not be penalized.

Hopeful Hunter- Open to horses and ponies. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' or 2'3" No oxers

Children's Hunter Pony- Open to ponies 14.2 and under. Riders must be 17 years of age and under. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 2' or 2'6"

Open Equitation- Open to Junior or Adult Amateur Riders, on horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, legs and general position and control of the mount. Fences 2'3" or 2'6"

Schooling Hunter- Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability & soundness. Fences 2'6"

Children/Adult Amateur Hunter- Open to Junior & Adult Amateurs on horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability & soundness. Fences 2'6" or 3'

Open Hunter- Open to horses. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Fences 3'

Open Card Warm Up- There will be two unjudged schooling rounds available throughout the day offered at 2', 2'3", 2'6" & 3'

1. Management, the Horse Show Committee, and/or Vintage Oaks Horse Farm, LLC will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, horse or equipment at the show.
2. Management reserves the right to divide, combine or cancel a class if necessary.
3. ASTM/SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds. Harness is required when jumping for all competitors.
4. For horse show purposes, the age of the exhibitor will be considered there age as of December 1st of the previous year.
5. No martingales permitted in under saddles classes.
6. The State of Pennsylvania requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a negative Coggins Certificate taken within the last year. You will be asked to present Coggins Certificate when picking up your number.
7. Supervised schooling permitted 6:30 to 7:45am.
8. Show start time 8am
9. A fee of \$50 will be charged, as well as bank fees reimbursed, for all returned checks.
10. Class Fee \$15 Office Fee \$10 (\$5 if pre-entered)
11. Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all divisions.
12. Six Ribbons will be awarded in all classes, unless otherwise stated.
13. WARNING-In accordance with PA Act #93 of 2005 you assume the risk of Equine Activities Pursuant to Pennsylvania Law.
14. Please use designated Parking Areas.
15. All dogs must be on a leash when on the property
16. Refreshments will be available on show grounds
17. Show will be held in outdoor ring with sand/fiber footing, schooling can be done in grass (weather dependent) or indoor riding ring with sand/fiber mix.

Directions:

From the South- Take 83 North to exit 36 MD-439. Turn Right at off ramp stop sign to head west on MD-439. At stop sign turn right to head north on York Rd/Main Street towards the MD Line. Continue straight through traffic light at MD/PA Line, turn right onto Southwood Rd (Across the street from New Freedom Restaurant). At stop sign turn left onto Oakwood Rd & follow horse show signs.

From the North- Take 83 South to exit 37 Freeland Rd. Merge right at stop sign, immediately at traffic light turn right to head north on Susquehanna Trail. Turn right onto Southwood Rd (Across the street from New Freedom Restaurant). At stop sign turn left onto Oakwood Rd & follow horse show signs.
