RULES & REGULATIONS

1. As per Maryland state requirements, ALL horses and ponies must present a negative Coggins, dated 12 months prior to show date, at the Show Office before any back number is issued.

2. NO OUTSIDE DOGS ALLOWED on the show grounds property.

3. Any individual mounted on a horse or pony at any time on the show grounds must wear protective headgear that meets current ASTM-SEI standards, with the harness secured.

4. Show management reserves the right to make changes to the show schedule as needed, including but not limited to: class locations, additions, cancellations, and combinations.

5. STALLIONS ARE BARRED from competition and show grounds.

6. A completed and signed release form (must be 18 or older to sign) and payment must be left with the show once before entry back number will be issued. Checks can be made out to <u>Vintage Oaks Farm</u>

All entries will be judged on soundness at the trot upon entering the ring. The decision of the ring's respective judge is final.
Vintage Oaks Farm, and the show management and staff assume no responsibility for any damage, accident, or injury which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, spectator, equipment, or vehicle at any time while on the show grounds.

9. Schooling will be permitted in ring until 8:45 am. Restrictions may be imposed during schooling to ensure exhibitor safety at the discretion of show management and show steward. Schooling break offered throughout the show day. Schooling prior to 7:30 am is at own individual risk.

10. A junior rider is anyone under 18 years of age as of December 1st of the previous year.

11. Six (6) ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded for each division.

12. SMOKING IS NOT PERMITTED at any time while on the show grounds.

13. All jumper classes open to horses or ponies, juniors and adults. First class of each division will be a table 2 2b.- You will do your first round and if clear of faults will remain in the ring and begin your jump off round at the bell. The second class of each division will be a table 2.1 only one timed round, jump faults to be penalized accordingly. Low schooling jumpers to jump a height of .95meters with spreads of .95meters. Medium schooling jumpers to jump a height of 1.0 meter with spreads of 1.0 meter. High schooling jumpers to jump a height of 1.05-1.10 meters.
